Aims and objectives:

The aim of the project "Unity in Diversity" is to understand peace education through cultural diversity and European Union values. Youngsters from Latvia, Germany, Turkey, Italy, Spain, Malta and Slovakia will unite to reduce their stereotypes, change their values and attitudes towards diversity.

Non formal education activities will be learning through creativity and culture, discussions, cultural evenings, traditions, social networking, flash moby and activities in public venues, conversations about peace, intercultural communication.

Participants of the project will improve their learning competences and will get their Youthpass, which can be useful instruments in their carriers. Inclusion of newcomers, refugees and asylum seekers in European Union Youth program will be a positive driver for lowering social risks. Between the participant countries a longterm international partnership will be developed to continue work with youth and newcomers. The results of the project will be disseminated in seven countries for around 210 youngsters that might use opportunities offered by European Union.
