# WHAT'S THE EXCHANGE ABOUT ?

## MAIN TOPIC & OBJECTIVES

The exchange is about "employability". The goals of the project is to :

- Discuss the European and local job-market from youngsters' point of view
- Give you the tools and know-how to integrate the job market
- Build an international and intercultural network where respect and tolerance are keys aspects

## PROJECT'S DURATION & LOCATIONS

The project happens in 3 phases

1. **Mobility in Guadeloupe** (7 days of activities - 2 travel days)

Between the 13/11/23 and 26/11/23 (exact dates to be confirmed).

2. **Local events**. After the first mobility, each national group will organise

- An "Open Day for Employment"
- A project with social impact for the local community

3. **Mobility in Bulgaria** (7 days of activities - 2 travel days)

## WHO CAN PARTICIPATE ?

Each country will send 4 youngsters (2 men/2 women) between 18 and 30 y.o.

You must be unemployed as the project is meant to support your integration into the job market.

Participating countries include : Guadeloupe, Spain, Croatia, Germany & Bulgaria.

## WHAT'S THE YOUTHPASS ?

Youthpass is the recognition instrument developed for the projects realised in the European youth programmes. Through the Youthpass certificate, participation in such projects can be recognised as an educational experience and a period of non-formal and informal learning.

## WHY IS THE YOUTHPASS ADVANTAGEOUS ?

You can attach the Youthpass to your CV, in order to show your future employer your commitment to a European project and the skills you developed.

The main difference with the Youthpass and a regular certificate is that you complete it yourself. That means you have the opportunity to create a very specific and individual report of what you've personally learned during the project !

Don't worry, your leader and sending association will help you ! You'll also have time in Guadeloupe to reflect on what you want to organise and how to do it.

## OPEN DAY FOR EMPLOYMENT

This day is meant to help other youngsters like you to find a job. With your group, you're free to organise the event in the most appropriate format. It can be face-to-face, hybrid, or fully virtual.

The main objective must be to provide youngsters with as many opportunities as possible (meeting with recruiters, public bodies, associations, presentation of ESC and E+ opportunities, etc.).

## EVENT WITH SOCIAL IMPACT

The key word of that event ? Solidarity !

What you exactly want to organise is up to your group. It could be a clean-up day, helping the elders, setting up an activity for kids, ... Whatever you find useful for your local community and interesting !

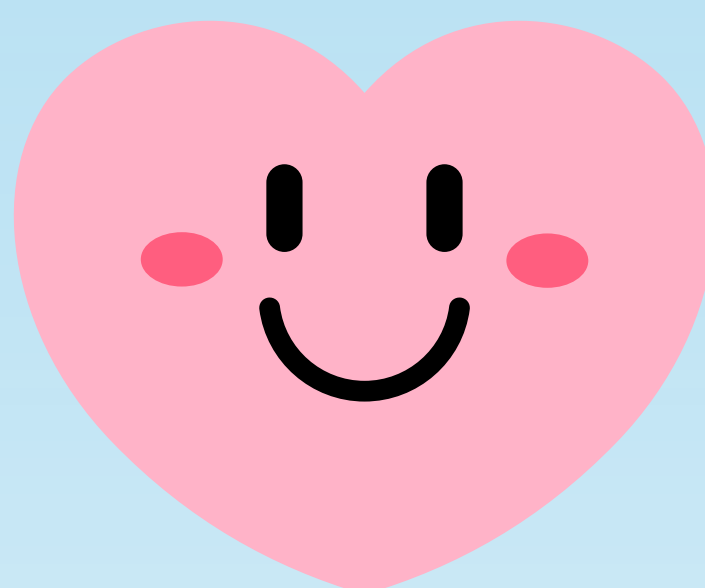
