

Yes, this is Your chance to be an opportunity for kids and young people in Balvi municipality, who can learn from you and teach you new things, as well as dive into the youth field, guided by Your professional colleagues and mentors, who will always be there for You!



#### **About us**

A small introduction

#### COORDINATOR

We, the association/NGO "Kalmārs", have been active in our community as an organization since 2013 and through this time have gained experience in different project implementations. We are the voice of youth in North Latgale, so our main focus is on the youth, as well with fewer opportunities, and as a result, the topics on which we focus are diverse, ranging from self-development to environmental issues, democratic principles, and debates with politicians!

Till now, we have had three long-term volunteer projects, hosted seven people, and have been through as well the the pandemic, so we have learned how to handle risks and celebrate our team's success! Next projects are short term team volunteering this Summer and our first mobility project for youth workers, to share our knowledge and peer to peer learning methods!

By the way, our team has a lot of volunteers, even our project manager is volunteering! And yes, we encourage our youngsters to be part of our team, so together we have a stronger voice and can implement different activities and create opportunities!

#### HOSTS

Balvi municipality's Children and Youth Center is the main host where you will be able to implement all the crazy good ideas as well as be a part of a creative team implementing different events, activities, workshops, lessons, etc.

The youth center has smaller centers in our municipality: Viļaka youth house, "Saulesszieds" in Semenova and Rugāju jauniešu centrs, it means that you won't get bored, because half the week you will be working in Balvi and the other half in smaller youth centers, where you can meet all the amazing kids and youngsters in the rural area! As well, the youth centers will organize school visits and meetings, so you can better introduce yourself to young people who will later come to the centers as well!

Balvi Youth Center also has interest groups in which you can participate: modern dance groups; ABC life skills; hands-on creativity; language lessons; technical lessons for working with 3D printer; singing groups; and even a room with drums to have some loud music!

Also, youth centers love to cooperate with other organizations, so there are a lot of opportunities for you, to implement your own small projects during your volunteer time!

#### **VOLUNTEERING**



#### General info

You will work with children and youth in the Balvi municipality (youth centers, schools, kinder gardens and other places where there is an interest in collaboration) - organizing various workshops, activities, language lessons, quizzes, culture events, sharing hobbies, and using various non-formal methods; learning about Latvian culture, activities, and methods from youth and center workers; and participating in already existing activities.

#### Living

The living will be in Balvi, in the Balvi State Gymnasium dormitory, in a separate room just for you. The facility has WCs, showers, Wi-Fi, laundry, a kitchen, and a living room with a TV—everything you need for a comfortable stay! There is a gym and a swimming pool nearby; work is a 17-minute walk away, and the bus station is a 10-minute walk away. The nearest store is a 2-minute walk away.



#### Numbers

The work week is 5 days and is 6-8 hours a day, including meetings with the mentor/supervisor, Latvian language learning, evaluation of the week, and main work with the kids and youth.




#### Work with us

## WEATHER IN LATVIA

#### **GOING TROUGH SEASONS**

Latvia is a country, where You can experience all four seasons: summer, spring, fall and winter.

The temperature through all year can be from -30°C to +30°C (mostly the big minuses are for couple weeks).

Weather is changing quite fast, so it is good to be prepared for that.

The Summer is nice and warm, but it can be as well rainy, the temperatures are between 16-18 °C to 26-28 °C.

The Fall starts to be more rainy and windy and the temperature starts to fall down, and it is normal to have snow storms in November.

The Winter usually starts in January, and gets really cold in the end of January/start of February (this year we had -30 °C some days as well, but it stayed for 2-3week -25 °C), December is an interesting month, sometimes it is a lot of snow, sometimes it is muddy.

The Spring at the start is cold, march is muddy and it is still snowing, temperature can be from -10 °C to +5 °C, the April is as well changing, windy and may is nice, gets warmer, more sun.

#### **CLOTHES**

Clothes for cold weather: warm jacket, hat, gloves, scarf, warm boots.

Clothes for rainy weather: waterproof shoes, water impervious jacket (or at least jacket what won't be wet after 10 minutes in rain), umbrella, rain coat.

Clothes for warm weather: shorts, t-shirts, swimming suit, flip-flops.

Everyday clothes: jeans, shirt, cardigan, sweater etc.

Sports clothes;

Going out clothes (concerts, events etc.).



## LIFE IN LATVIA

#### FOOD

In summer time there are different veggies: potatoes, carrots, cabbages, gourds, tomatoes, onions, beets, cucumbers, peas etc.; as well there are different fruits: strawberries, blackberries, black and red currants, cherries, blueberries etc.;

In fall we have apples, plums, pears, raspberries, mushrooms, wild berries etc.

All year around there is access to different kind of meat: pork, chicken, beef etc. and dairy products: cheese, yogurt, cream, cottage cheese etc;

For winter time there is canned food from veggies, juices, syrups, jams etc., in shops there are imported vegetables and fruits.



## **BALVI MUNICIPALITY**

Balvi municipality is an important center of Northern Latgale, which was established in 2021 as a result of the reform. The municipality comprises the town of Balvi and Vileka and 19 parishes- Baltinava, Balvi, Bērzkalnes, Bērzpils, Briežuciems, Krišjāņi, Kubuli, Kuprava, Lazdukalns, Lazduleja, Medneva, Rugaji, Susaji, Šķilbēni, Tilža, Vectilža, Vecumi, Viksna and Žīguri.

The unique image of the region is created by the waters of rivers and lakes, the beauty of unspoiled nature, the rich cultural and historical heritage of the Latgalians and, of course, the hard-working and kind people of the region.

The total area of the territory of Balvi Municipality is 1868.29 km2.

Population of Balvi municipality - 19 955 (PMLP data 2021-10-14).

The municipality is located in the north-east of Latvia, bordering the municipalities of Aluksne, Gulbene, Rezekne, Ludza and Madona.

The Balvi municipality identifies itself as an important centre of Northern Latgale, where modern cultural and ethnographic traditions are nurtured.

The vision of the development of the cultural sphere of Balvi region is: Balvi region - the bearer and preserver of the cultural heritage of Northern Latgale.

Coat of arms: Black wolf's head and rising silver sun on purple red background.

Flag: The light white stripe symbolizes the white soul and spiritual values. The silver-coloured band symbolizes - "earthly" values, silver "mirrors".
