HOW TO COME TO "SCOUT CHALET KÄL" IN KAYL TÉTANGE?

!!! IMPORTANT INFO: PUBLIC TRANSPORT IN LUXEMBOURG IS FREE !!! SO TRAIN, BUS AND TRAM ARE FREE TO TRAVEL AROUND THE COUNTRY)

!!! THE INTERNET SITE OR APP CALLED WWW.MOBILITEIT.LU CAN HELP WITH PUBLIC TRANSPORT SCHEDULES !!!

- By plane we have nowadays RYANAIR, EASY JET, TAP PORTUGAL AIRLINES, TURKISH AIRLINES, KLM... So just look for the best price for direct flies to Luxembourg Airport.
- But there can be cheap indirect flies for example to Frankfurt-Main (Germany) or to Charleroi (Belgium) Airport and take a FLIBCO Bus (www.flibco.com) (usually the price is around 5€ to 27€)
- Then there is a possibility to get here by train you need to go to Luxembourg Main Station and take a train to Esch/Alzette. There you can take the bus Line N°4
- Another possibility is coming by Megabus, BLA BLA Bus or other companies who are travelling to Luxembourg. It can be very cheap but long travel. Just look for the cheapest Bus company.

!!! IT IS IMPORTANT TO LET THE ORGANIZERS OF LUXEMBOURG KNOW YOUR ARRIVAL TIME IN LUXEMBOURG



You can take the Busline 601 which departs from Luxembourg Gare Rocade to Kayl and go out of the Station names "Kayl Post" (City Center) and from there it's about 20min walk.

- BRING A LAPTOP OR ANY OTHER DIGITAL TOOL TO USE IN THE WORKSHOPS (IF NOT POSSIBLE, WE CAN PROVIDE SOME)

In Luxembourg all major credit and debit cards are accepted. However, close to the Venue there is no Shop or ATM. There is a small supermarket called "Epicerie Fernandes" not far away (20min walk) where you can go buy things to eat or drink.

Shopping list can be done If you have forgotten anything at home i.e. toothbrush or deodorant, we will have a shopping list. You can leave money with the person responsible for shopping and we will get it for you within 24 hours.

Insurance






Every participant should have valid travel insurance for Luxembourg during your stay on the project. This means that when you don't have your own insurance card (luxembourg CNS), the organizer doesn't bear any responsibilities towards the participants. That is why every participant should timely purchase their own insurance. (you could take it from DKV its cheap and effective)

House Keeping



Since the venue is from another association and in the middle of a side street there are Privat houses close, so it is important to keep this place clean all the time, and don't make too much noise OUTSIDE. So everyone is responsible for taking care of the place and all participants will contribute to making it clean and nice for everyone. Music Outside isn't allowed after 22h but still you can go listen to it inside the Venue. So please always check if the venue is clean and if after 22h Noise isn't too loud outside.
