We are looking for participants who will actively engage in every phase of the project, developing a creative process about the relation between the global south and north and our connectivity with the other beings around.

Participants will receive free accommodation and meals, with all costs covered by the Erasmus+ Programme.

WHAT IS LAGI

LOCAL ACTION, GLOBAL IMPACT

Local Action, Global Impact is a youth exchange project that invites participants to reflect on environmental and social challenges through the interconnected relationships between human and other-than-human beings. The project will bring together 46 young people aged 18–25 from six different countries to explore how local actions are directly linked to broader global processes and ecosystems.

Through performing arts and sensorial practices, participants will investigate the relationship between body, territory, and environment, reflecting on how individual and collective choices resonate beyond geographical borders. The project adopts a collaborative and site-sensitive creative approach, addressing the interdependence between the personal, the local, and the global.

Together, the group will co-create installations, photo-performances, and live performances. The creative process will be guided by values of respect, care, empathy, collaboration, and critical reflection on present challenges—rooted in the past and oriented toward reimagining possible futures.

METHODOLOGY

Participants will work in small intercultural groups to explore key themes such as humanity, different ways of inhabiting the land, coexistence between human and more-than-human beings, interdependence, and the unequal relationships between different communities. Through guided discussion, embodied exploration, and creative exercises, participants will reflect on how these themes connect to their own personal experiences, territories, and social realities. These collective reflections will be translated into an artistic creation process, where each group will design and build a site-specific installation. Inside this shared space, participants will develop a photo-performance and a live performative action, using body, movement, voice, objects, and visual composition as tools for expression. The final outcomes will not aim to provide answers, but to open questions, provoke dialogue, and invite the audience to reflect on our shared responsibility toward the planet and each other.



Participants will receive creative tools and guidance through workshops and shared sessions. The process will end with an intimate, non-public sharing and moments of collective and individual reflection.

- Interested in environmental and social topics;
- Interested in using artistic tools, such as visual and performing arts;
- Motivated to explore an intercultural environment;

- Able to attend to the whole project from the 20th of May (arrival day) to the 27th of May (departure day) (one free day in the middle of the project).

We will share this experience in a very special place, surrounded by nature, founded in 1957 on the outskirts of Llinars del Vallés, 50km far from Barcelona.

ACCOMMODATION

We will stay at the 'Refugi' (refuge) building, with a capacity for 70 people. On the ground floor, there is a kitchen, dining room, and two rooms. The first floor consists of 10 shared rooms, equipped with 6 to 8 beds, and two bathroom areas

The beds are prepared with sheets and blankets, and towels will be provided, so you only need to bring your personal hygiene kit.

Additionally, meals will be adapted to the specific dietary requirements each participant has indicated on the Personal Information Sheet.

How to get there??



All participants will use public transportation for arrival and departure. The best option is to take the R2 Nord train line, which offers a direct route from El Prat Airport (“Aeroport” station) to Llinars del Vallès, with an approximate travel time of 1 hour and 10 minutes.

Tickets cannot be purchased in advance, but they are available at ticket machines and sales offices located in the train stations.





