CONDITIONS

You are expected to work 6 hours per day, 5 days a week. The usual working days are Monday to Friday, however, you may occasionally be asked to take part in events during the weekend. In such cases, you will receive a day off during the following working week.

You will work alongside Caritas staff and be supervised by the Volunteering Coordinator. You will also have regular meetings with the Project Coordinator and receive ongoing mentoring. During your mobility, you are entitled to 2 days of holiday for each working month, which you may use for personal purposes such as travelling, self-development, or quality relaxation time.



FINANCIAL SUPPORT

- Pocket money – 6 Euro / Day
- Food money – 500 PLN
- Local transportation to and back from work will be fully funded
- Travel reimbursement according to the guide call 2025

FURTHER INFORMATION

Training

General Online Training is available primarily to registered candidates and participants selected for an activity. It is offered through the EU Academy platform and accessed via the European Solidarity Corps portal.

Trainings provided by the National Agency, including:

- On-arrival training, which is obligatory for all participants (usually held in Warsaw).
- Mid-term training, required for participants whose mobility lasts longer than 6 months (usually held in Toruń).

You will also receive access to a Polish course on the EU Academy as well as an additional Polish language course to help you gain basic language skills.

Working with seniors at the Senior Club and supporting them in their everyday life

Enriching seniors' daily activities, assisting with the organization of the facility, and engaging in cultural exchange by learning each other's languages and traditions. Activities may include preparing presentations about your home country, playing games, participating in outings, supporting digital skills (such as helping with digitalization and smartphones), and assisting in organizing events at the center.

It is highly appreciated if you bring your own initiative, share your hobbies and interests, and introduce new ideas. If you are interested in social media, it would be very helpful if you could support us in this area as well.

You may also be asked to support the staff with logistics and help keep the place clean and tidy.
